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**AWARENESS AND SKILLS ACQUISITION OF ENTREPRENEURSHIP IN
DATABASE MANAGEMENT AMONG LIBRARY AND INFORMATION SCIENCE
STUDENTS AT THE UNIVERSITIES OF UYO AND CALABAR, NIGERIA**

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Abstract

This study examines the integration of entrepreneurship training into database management (DBM), with specific objective of ascertaining the awareness of entrepreneurship opportunities and acquisition of skills in Database Management (DBM) among library and information science (LIS) students in two federal universities in Nigeria. Frequency tables and simple percentage were used to analyse and interpret data. Survey design was used to gather data while simple percentages were used in analysing the data. Findings show that over 60% students were not aware of entrepreneurship in DBM and the market opportunity; and they had not acquired relevant skills that would enable them function effectively as entrepreneurs in DBM. Recommendations were made towards the training of Library and Information Science(LIS) students for entrepreneurship in database management.
